Acceptable Identification

Home » Acceptable Identification

An applicant must have two pieces of identification, one of which must be government-issued and include applicant's name, date of birth, signature and photo of the applicant.

Photo Identification Standards (Government Issued)

- · Driver's License (issued by Canadian province or territory)
- · Foreign Driver's License
- · Canadian / Foreign Passport
- · Canadian Citizenship Card
- · Permanent Resident (PR) Card
- · Certificate of Indian Status
- International Student Identity Card
- Firearms Acquisition Certificate (FAC)
- Canadian National Institute of the Blind (CNIB) Identification Card
- Federal, provincial, or municipal employee identification card
- Military Family Identification Card (MFID)
- Health Card (with photo)
- · Student Card (with photo)
- NEXUS CARD

If you are unable to supply Identification from this list, your alternative is to submit fingerprints to the R.C.M.P. for search and comparison.

A second piece of ID may include the following:

- Birth Certificate
- Baptismal Certificate
- Immigration Documents
- Marriage Certificate
- Ontario Age of Majority Card
- Student Card (with photo)

- Employment I.D. (with photo)
- · Vehicle Insurance or Ownership
- Utility Bills or Government mail with your name and current address

We do not accept S.I.N. or credit cards for identification purposes.
