



# CRIME ALERT

During February 2019 the Hamilton Police Service investigated numerous Break and Enters and Mischiefs to trailer units on the property at Gulliver's Lake RV Resort and Campground in the City of Hamilton (Flamborough), ON. Approximately 75 units were affected resulting in thousands of dollars of either damage or loss to the residents of the community. The park is similar to yours in that it's seasonal and was closed during that time. The suspects appeared to have either walked in on foot or used smaller motor vehicles like snowmobiles or ATVs to enter the park. **This incident appears to be isolated and there is no immediate need for concern.**

The Hamilton Police Service would like to assist you with being better prepared to help deter this kind of crime in your park/resort. Even though the likeliness of this happening during open season is rare given that your park will be occupied with many residents at the time, there are still precautions that can be taken in the event that you will be absent for any period of time. An easy reference pamphlet has been created for your consideration. Some of our suggestions may seem rudimentary and might require some cost to acquire, but they may greatly reduce your chances of becoming a victim of this type of property crime in the future.
