## **DETAILS**

- Victim Services is a Branch of the Hamilton Police Service. It is a 24 hr on scene crisis intervention service for victims of crime and trauma. Specially trained volunteers provide practical assistance, emotional support and referrals.
- Victim Services Branch volunteers are required to volunteer a minimum of 32 hours of on call availability per month (4 x 8 hour shifts) including a mix of weekday and weekend shifts
- Attend initial 12 week evening training program and annual quarterly professional development

## **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

- Canadian Citizen or permanent resident of Canada
- 21 years of age or older
- Valid "G" class driver's license and access to a vehicle
- Basic computer skills to navigate online scheduling system
- Reside within the City of Hamilton
- Excellent listening skills

## **RECRUITING PROCESS INCLUDES:**

- Online application submitted with resume and cover letter
- Group orientation
- Interview
- Background investigation
- Vulnerable Sector Check
